Private Arts and Crafts Tour

Explore Rarotonga Arts and Crafts heritage from the comfort of an air-conditioned coach as our experienced local guide takes you on a fascinating 4 hours tour.

The first stop will be at Koteka Winery where you will taste vanilla extracts, banana and chilli liqueurs and also spirits of delicious flavours. After that, you will learn about the production of the local beer of the Cook Islands at Matutu Brewery.

The tour then continues to Rito, a small family business that produces organic cosmetics with cold pressed coconut oil. You will meet Natua and his ukulele laboratory and learn the art of creating pareu and the famous Ei, the traditional crown meticulously handmade with fresh flowers.

Along the route you will visit the Gallery of Kay George, a local artist known for her unique style producing beautiful hand-painted fabrics, paintings and photographs. You will meet Madam Anne at her store specializing in Tivaevae collections, a type of artistic quilting, learned and further developed from the time of the English missionaries.

The next stop will be at Perfumes of Rarotonga, for souvenirs, perfumes and fragrant natural soaps and the Beachcomber, an old building of colonial architecture. Inside the building you will see a contemporary art gallery, a pearl shop and TAV, a fashion store specializing in Pacific Designer apparel. You will also learn about the art of pearl carving with Tokerau Jim, one of the best black pearls carvers in the world.

Your lunch break at the Mooring Fish Cafe will be the perfect opportunity to taste delicious fresh fish caught by Captain Moko and cooked by his lovely wife.
